## Safety instructions

## General safety instructions

- All electrical connection works must be carried out by an authorised electrician.
- Machines may be operated only with functioning safety devices.
- Only trained personnel may operate the machine.
- Only trained personnel may carry out maintenance and repair work.
- Never work under the influence of illnesses that affect concentration abilities, medication, drugs or alcohol.
- Always disconnect the machine from the power supply before carrying out maintenance or repair work.
- Wear tight-fitting clothing and remove all items that can get caught in the machine.
- Use genuine spare parts and accessories.
- Keep body parts away from moving machine parts.
- If any malfunctions or anomalies occur, operation must be suspended immediately until the cause has been identified and the fault has been rectified.
- Avoid overloading the machine. Always work within the authorised performance range (see technical data).
- Always ensure that there are no persons present in the danger zones of the machine.
- Before using the machine, ensure that the safety devices are functioning properly.
- Read the operating instructions and familiarise yourself with the safety devices.
- Keep the work area clean and tidy to minimise safety hazards.
- Do not modify the machine.
